- Entry fee for each car is \$25.00. Each car entered comes with two pit passes. Additional pit passes are \$5.00 each.
- Drivers must have a valid driver's license or be of legal driving age in the State of Indiana (over 16 years and 90 days old).
- Mini-cars must be any 4-cyl front wheel drive / 6 cyl front wheel drive mini vans.
- Anyone in the pit area must wear long pants and closed toe shoes. No shorts or sandals allowed in the pits.
- No use of alcoholic beverages before or during competition.
- The derby will be run in two or more heats with the top two cars going on to the feature. All cars will be inspected prior to the start of the derby and the top two cars from each heat will be re-inspected prior to the feature. If your car does not pass inspection your car will not be allowed to run. Entry fees will not be refunded. Judges decisions are final.
- All glass, excluding the windshield, must be removed from the car.
- No chrome is to be left on the exterior of the car.
- Rear seat must be removed.
- Gas tank must be put in the rear seat area of the car.
- Battery must be put in the front passenger area of the car, both must be mounted securely.
- No profanity is to be painted on the cars.
- Doors must be chained or welded shut. Driver's door must be painted white. The car must have a 12" inspection hole in the hood and trunk.
- Any stock style- 13, 14, 15, 16 inch tire or snow tire may be used. No fluid filled tires allowed.
- No reinforcements of frame or body allowed. Cars must have factory bumpers. No hitches allowed. Suspension must be stock. No welding of shocks (must have movement). Must have working brakes.
- All drivers must wear helmet, long sleeve shirt, and the seat belt must be worn at all times. Idle speed only in the pit area.
- Cash prizes will be awarded to the top three places in both features based on the entry fees collected; this varies from year to year. To be decided prior to the race by the participates as to how the monies will be paid.
- Cash prizes for the final event will be paid to the last car still running and able to move. To be decided prior to the race by the participating drivers as to how the payouts will be made.
- Registration starts at 5:30PM and race to start at 7:00PM.
- All cars must have numbers painted using bright colors and easily seen on the doors, trunk, and hood.
- Thank you for your co-operation to these simple rules and we hope each of you have a safe and fun packed event. The crowds look forward to your race.
